

Fasting is a part of the practices of many religions including, Islam, Judaism and Christianity. Today many people are trying to dig up the benefits of fasting. Some people fast for spiritual reasons while others fast as a way to physically discipline their bodies.

Whatever reasons one might come up with, it has been scientifically proved that fasting has tremendous health, spiritual and physical benefits. It is known that fasting helps eliminate or neutralize toxins through the colon, liver, kidneys, lungs and skin. It leads to the cleansing of the whole body. The healing process can be noticed clearly in the body during a fast. Besides, dangerous diseases such as cancer do not have the full support of the body's supplies during fasting and thus, they won't increase.

In addition to these physical benefits of fasting, it helps people to feel for needy and support them by giving money and food.
